Public holidays

Place all food scraps in your green organics bin

This includes meat, dairy, seafood, processed/baked goods, condiments/sauces. View the full list of acceptable items on our website.

Place them in loose, in a paper bag, wrapped in newspaper or use compostable bags – look for the certified compostable logo.

OTHER WASTE AND RECYCLING SERVICES

Additional bins

For an annual fee you can get additional waste, recycling and green organics bins.

Free green organics drop-off

We offer residents a free green organics drop-off service to help manage your extra garden waste. Contact us to register for a voucher code. This service is not available to commercial operators.

Hard waste collections

Each household can access two collections per financial year to dispose of items that are too large to go in the kerbside collection bins.

Composting at home subsidy

We offer residents compost bins, worm farms and Bokashi buckets at a subsidised cost. There are also free workshops so you can learn how to do it.
